MY PLANTS LOOK ROUGH. SHOULD I BE CONCERNED?

Plants that are shipped with leaves on will often wilt or turn yellow from lack of sun, and heat of a closed box. This is natural. Follow our directions (reverse side) on watering and setting in shade, and they will recover within a week or two.



MY PLANT HAS NO LEAVES:

Many plants we send are dormant during the fall/winter season; leading to no leaves on them. In the spring/fall we will also remove leaves on some plants while packing if we are concerned the plant will stress during the heat of transit. Please do not be concerned, the leaves will return.

WHAT IF MY PLANT IS DAMAGED?

Despite our best efforts, sometimes they are damaged in transit. If you've received a damaged plant, **STOP** and take pictures of the damaged box and any damage to the plants. If you have any damaged limbs they can be trimmed for a clean prune without any concern for the tree. Limbs will re-grow. If the main trunk is broken, take photos of the plant INSIDE THE BOX to show how the damage occurred. We cannot reimburse you for your plants without photos. Once we file the claim with the shipper, we'll send you replacement plants.

REMOVE FROM BOX + BAG:

Remove the plant(s) from the box AND remove the bag from around the pot. If you have a bush type plant, cut the tape to release the branches. Water as soon as possible.

PUT IN SHADE. NOT SUN:

Immediate direct sunlight can damage your plants. Put the plants in a shady area for a couple of days to help them adjust. After this period, move all plants (except Paw Paws) to full sun. Paw Paws are shade lovers, leave them in the shade.





WATER DAILY:

Water your plants daily. We water our plants daily at the nursery, so they are dependent on daily watering. Try to plant within a few months. If you cannot plant them within this time frame, be sure to move them to a large pot.

NOTE

If you're gardening in a colder climate, zone 8a and below, hold any plants that have new growth on them until temperatures are above freezing in your area. If you have questions about when it is best to plant your plant, contact us.
